Dr. Selma Miller, a licensed family therapist with extensive experience in moderating sibling support groups, leads our new sibling support group. Siblings of children on the autism spectrum often struggle with complex emotions and unvoiced concerns. This is a wonderful opportunity for those siblings to have a safe place to share and explore their feelings and experiences and for them to meet others who may have similar experiences.

Space is limited to 8 children, ages 8 to 12, for each monthly session. Registration is on a first come, first served basis. We hope that parents consider whether their children will be able to attend all or most of the six sessions scheduled thus far for continuity and so that children feel safe and comfortable.
